Educational Scholarship Grant

Four Financial Assistance Grants of \$1500 will be awarded annually by the Connecticut Building Officials Association. Applications are available by download at <https://www.ctbuildingofficial.org>

I. ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUALS:

- a. Children or Grandchildren of an active member at time of application.
- b. Children or Grandchildren of a former C.B.O.A. member who died while on active-duty list.
- c. Children or Grandchildren of a retired C.B.O.A. member who is in good standing.

II. REQUIREMENTS FOR CONSIDERATION

- a. Applications must be completed in full and submitted to the Educational Grant Committee no later than May 31, 2026
- b. Applications must have signature of the sponsoring member. (For deceased members, a signature of any member in good standing)
- c. Candidates must be accepted as a freshman student at an accredited Junior College, College, University or accredited technical school with Associates degree offered.
- d. Candidates must be residents of Connecticut.
